Dear Dr. Spandorfer:

Thank you for your December 7, 2023 letter regarding the above matter. Westat appreciates the important role that SART plays in assisting its Member Clinics with reporting data to the National ART Surveillance System. However, it is not appropriate for us to work through an intermediary with respect to the detailed questions you have posed regarding the incident. Such communications must be directly between the clinics, who are the data owners, and Westat.
